King Phalo Airport instrument landing system (ILS) procedure approved

Air Traffic and Navigation Services (ATNS) SOC Ltd is pleased to announce that the Instrument Landing System (ILS) for Runway 11 at King Phalo Airport has received approval from the South African Civil Aviation Authority (SACAA) for upliftment and operation.

This approval means that both runways (29 and 11) at King Phalo Airport will have valid operational procedures, which will enhance airport operations and reduce flight disruptions, particularly during inclement weather conditions.
