***The Citizen newspaper article: “Jobs for pals threat”***

Air Traffic and Navigation Services (ATNS) SOC Limited has noted The Citizen newspaper article “Jobs for pals threat” published on Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

The article refers to a letter allegedly “penned by concerned staff” and sent to the Minister of Transport, Ms. Barbara Creecy, and the Public Protector, Ms. Kholeka Gcaleka.

“ATNS is aware of the circulating dossier and complaint laid with the Public Protector and the Minister of Transport,” says ATNS Chairman Mr. Zola Majavu (CD) SA.

Mr Majavu continued, “We have since written to the Public Protector and pledged our full cooperation with any investigation. We respect the rule of law and fairness and therefore we will not comment in the media but rather within applicable processes.”

The Board Chairman emphasised the importance of respecting the rights of the ATNS executives implicated in the dossier while the necessary investigations unfold.
