**AIRSPACE RESTRICTIONS**

***This supplement replaces S01/24.***

***Validity Period: 10 July 2025 – 08 July 2026***

***Ukraine Crisis:*** airspace restriction issued by the United Kingdom Department of Transport - No aircraft which is owned, chartered, or operated by persons connected with Russia or which is registered in Russia shall fly in St. Helena airspace, including the airspace above the territorial sea. This regulation does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of the United Kingdom Secretary of State for Transport.
